Vermont PBS and VPR Team Up for Election Poll

Colchester, VT – July 23, 2018 – What do Vermonters think about the coming election? What are the key issues on their minds? Vermont PBS and Vermont Public Radio have released the full results of a joint statewide poll that measures Vermonters' opinions the candidates and issues.

Vermont PBS and VPR conducted the public opinion poll from July 6 to July 16. The poll was conducted by Braun Research under the direction of Rich Clark, professor of political science at Castleton University and the former director of the Castleton Polling Institute. The poll surveyed 603 people living in all of Vermont's 14 counties via landline and mobile phone.
